A message about Coronavirus/COVID-19



PAD is a serious condition, and delayed treatment may lead to complications. We encourage you to keep and show up for your scheduled appointments. **All NIRP locations are open**, fully operational, and committed to a **safe** and **clean** environment for our patients and staff. In response to the evolving **COVID-19** situation, **NIRP** has implemented the following **CDC-recommended sterilization** and **disinfecting precautions**:

- 1 All patients and visitors are screened by phone for any signs of respiratory illness and if present, their appointments are postponed.
- 2 Upon arrival, patients and visitors are given the option to wait in their vehicles until it is time to take the patient back to the clinical area.
- 3 Limit 1 visitor per patient policy (visitors must be at least 18yo)
- 4 Disinfecting all rooms & equipment after each use.
- 5 Employees washing hands thoroughly after each patient interaction.
- 6 Employees wearing personal protective equipment (PPE).
- 7 Sanitizing wipes available to all patients and visitors.
- 8 Masks are mandatory for all staff, patients and visitors.

NIRP Recommended Guidelines

As with any other contagious disease, we understand the concerns regarding this matter. However, we would like to emphasize the following:

Patients should not delay seeking medical care as PAD is a serious and progressive disease if left untreated.

Patients with wounds or ulcers can be at risk for infection or amputation if medical care is not sought in time.

We recommend you continue with your PAD care in order to avoid disease progression and long-term negative effects.
